BACKGROUND

The Geography Olympiad is a competition held to test students' abilities and knowledge in the field of Geography. This event is designed to encourage students to deepen their knowledge of Geography and develop their potential. The Geography Olympiad is attended by students from various levels, from Senior High School to University level. Participants will be tested with various questions related to basic Geography concepts in everyday life.

OBJECTIVE

- Increasing students' interest and motivation towards Geography
- Explain critical and creative thinking skills for students
- Preparing students to compete in international events

LEVEL

- Senior High School
- University

PARTICIPANT CRITERIA

- This competition is a team competition consisting of 2 members from the same school
- Participants are students from Senior High School to University levels
- Registration of participants can be done by schools through their representatives by filling out the Registration Form
- Have Olympiad equipment in the form of computers/gadgets/smartphones, internet networks, and other necessary equipment

COMPETITION MECHANISM

- This competition is a team competition consisting of 2 people and is held online
- All teams will take part in the Olympiad which will be held online and in real time following the Indonesian Time Zone or WIB (Jakarta Time)
- The syllabus for each level will be sent to the team leader's email after the Participant has made payment
- Each winner will get 1 medal for each team and a certificate per name
- Each participant will get time according to the committee's provisions. Late attendance will reduce the allotted time

CRITERIA ASSESSMENT

- Assessment is carried out using a points system
- Each multiple choice question has a value of 1 point
- Olympiad participants will compete for rankings in the form of:
 - KKM > 80: will received a Gold Medal
 - KKM 70 – 79: will received a Silver Medal
 - KKM < 69: will received a Bronze Medal





GEOGRAPHY

MECHANISM OF COMPETITION

International Youth Geography Olympiad (IYGO) consists of two assessment rounds, each contributing a specific weight to the final overall score. Both rounds use a multiple-choice format but evaluate different levels of comprehension and analytical ability.

Round 1

Round 1 contributes 65% to the total score

This round focuses on broad conceptual understanding and rapid reasoning across various scientific topics. It is designed to assess participants' foundational knowledge and their ability to respond accurately under time constraints.

Round 2

Round 2 contributes the remaining 35% to the total score

Although this round also uses multiple-choice questions, it emphasizes higher-order thinking skills. The questions are structured to measure deeper analytical ability, interpretation of data, and the application of scientific principles in more complex contexts.

The combined score from both rounds determines each participant's final ranking and award category in the Olympiad.
